The IQAC Coordinator informed the members that Bhagwan Aadinath College of Education, Village Maharra, Lalitpur has been included in the list of Autonomous Colleges approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC) with effect from the Academic Session 2025–26. The autonomy is valid up to 2034–35 and the college shall function as an Autonomous Institution under the academic oversight of Bundelkhand University, Jhansi.

Resolved that all quality initiatives be implemented from August 2025 onwards and monitored by IQAC.

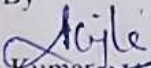
Action Taken Plan (2025–2027)
